MISSIONS ENCOUNTER AGREEMENT (Please read carefully)

(This agreement is between the Encounter participant, the sending church and Foursquare Missions.)

1. Statement of Faith

1. The Bible is God-inspired (2 Tim. 3:16,17) 2. God is Triune: Father, Son and Holy Spirit (2 Corin. 13:14) 3. Man was created in the image of God, but that by voluntary disobedience he fell from perfection (Rom. 5:12) 4. That while we were yet sinners Christ died for us, signing the pardon for all who believe in Him (John 3:16; Rom. 5:8) 5. We have no righteousness and must come to God, pleading the righteousness of Christ (Eph. 2:8) 6. That upon sincere repentance and a whole-hearted acceptance of Christ, we are justified before God (Rom. 10:6-10; 1 John 1:9) 7. The change which takes place in the heart and life at conversion is a very real one (2 Corin. 5:17; Gal. 2:20) 8. It is the will of God that we are sanctified daily, growing constantly in the faith (Heb. 6:1) 9. Baptism by immersion is an outward sign of an inward work (Matt. 28:19) and in the Commemoration of the Lord's Supper by the symbolical use of the bread and the juice of the vine (1 Corin. 11:24,25) 10. The baptism with the Holy Spirit empowers believers and that His incoming is after the same manner as in Bible days (Acts 2:4) 11. It is the will of God that we daily walk in the Spirit (Eph. 4:30-32) 12. The Holy Spirit has gifts to bestow upon the Christian (1 Corin. 12:1-11) and that we should show spiritual fruit as evidence of a Spirit-filled life (Gal. 5:22) 13. The experience and daily walk of the believer should never lead him into extremes of fanaticism (1 Tim. 2:8-10; Col. 3:17; Phil. 4:5) 14. Divine healing is the power of Christ to heal the sick in answer to the prayer of faith (James 5:14-16) 15. The second coming of Christ is personal and imminent (1 Thes. 4:16,17) It is our sacred duty to identify ourselves with the visible Church of Jesus Christ (Acts 16:5; Hebrews 10:25) 17. Laws should be upheld at all times, except in things opposed to the will of God (Rom. 13:1-5) 18. Some day all shall stand before the judgment seat of Christ to there receive eternal life or death (Rev. 20:11-15; Heb. 9:27; 2 Corin. 5:10) 19. Heaven is the glorious eternal home of born-again believers (John 14:1-3; Rev. 7:15-17) 20. Hell is the place of eternal torment for all who reject Christ as their Savior (Rev. 20:10-15) 21. Soul winning is the primary responsibility of the Church (James 5:20) 22. The method ordained of God for the support and spread of His cause is by giving tithes and free-will offerings (Malachi 3:10; 2 Corin. 9:7).

I have read the above Statement of Faith and I understand that all teaching and training will hold to this statement.

2. Who raises the money for the participant?

The Encounter participant and his or her sponsoring (“sending”) church agree to raise all financial support for his or her assignment. All expenses incurred while serving as an Encounter participant will be the responsibility of the participant and the sending church. In the event of an early return by the participant for whatever reason (examples: a family emergency, a “drop” in the level of funding, disciplinary action, etc...), the sending church agrees to either supply the funds so that the participants can complete their assignment or cover the cost of bringing the participant back home. (Note: some sending churches address this by asking the participant to purchase a round-trip airline ticket.)

3. Who processes the support funds?

Funds received for the participant should be accounted for by the sending church’s financial administrator. The church will receive and disburse all funds for the participant, issue tax-deductible receipts to the donors (for U.S. participants only) and issue annual compensation reports (form W2 or 1099-MISC) to the participant and the U.S. government. The church can either set up a special account or the participant’s funds, or the church can carefully keep track of the funds in one of the church accounts.

4. What about medical insurance?

The Encounter participant will agree to carry health/medical insurance for the duration of their time at the Missions Encounter, at their expense. Proof of insurance will be required for applicants file.

5. What else should we know?

The participant agrees to return home as directed, should the WorldBase leadership, or the sending church determine it is necessary to conclude the assignment prior to the completion of the Encounter.

Dating/romantic involvement at an Encounter would call for a review of the participant’s status and potentially result in immediate conclusion of their participation of the Encounter. Other activities that are discouraged and would call for a review include: inability to meet financial obligations, inability to live up to the Code of Conduct, or any other circumstances or activities that might hinder a participant’s ability to complete the Encounter in a satisfactory manner.
